TAKING CARE OF YOUR OILED OAK CUPBOARD

As your cupboard has a natural oiled finish, it is well protected with oil, but won't be completely impervious to marking,

Over time, your cupboard will build up the rich, warm patina of time and use. To ensure the longevity of the cupboard, and the continued beauty of the surface, please consider the guidance that follows.

CARE

This is a traditional finish that we love to use on busy work surfaces. Our oiled finishes are hard wearing and resistant to most spillages. However, any spills should be wiped immediately to avoid any chance of obvious marking. Avoid dragging objects across the surfaces and to prevent marking, ensure the surfaces are protected from extreme heat.

If you wish to avoid any obvious marking of the cupboard, please use mats under anything that is likely to drip or spill.

CLEANING

A soft, lightly dampened cloth should be used to wipe the cupboard clean from time to time. Periodically, the cupboard can be wiped with Osmo spray cleaner to clean and moisturise the timber.
