## TAKING CARE OF YOUR LOUPE LIGHT

### CLEANING

We recommend cleaning the loupe light with a soft cloth. The surface should only be gently wiped or dusted, avoiding heavy pressure on the surface.

Patination by oxidation is an organic process and the finish on an item can be damaged by using household cleaners or rubbing the surface vigorously. Please avoid using wax-polish or any other abrasive cleaner.

### ENVIRONMENT

Your light is made from solid brass, and as a 'live surface' will never stop responding to its environment. This is wonderful thing! However, it does mean that fast, extreme, or imbalanced changes in temperature or humidity may affect both the aesthetic quality and longevity of the piece so should be avoided.

### BULBS AND LAMP FITTINGS

The lights can be lit with E27 bulbs and we recommend a 80mm globe style. All bulbs should be changed when the lamp fitting is switched off. Screw-in bulbs should be firmly screwed into the fitting before switching on, or it's possible that shorting may occur. We continuity and PAT test all lighting at the time of making.
