TAKING CARE OF YOUR OILED TIMBER SEATING

CARE

This is a traditional surface that we love to use on much-used pieces of furniture. Our oiled finishes are hard wearing and resistant to wine, juice and olive oil spillages. However, any spills should still be wiped immediately to avoid any chance of obvious marking.

CLEANING

A soft, lightly dampened cloth should be used to wipe the piece clean. To have continued protection, the piece should be oiled periodically. Ensure the surface is clean and dry, then smooth on a thin layer of natural oil with a soft lint-free cloth (we like Osmo Top Oil in clear matt) and remove any excess. This helps to nourish and protect the surface and will develop a warm, natural patina over time. If you wish to avoid any obvious marking of the furniture please remove any spillages as soon as possible.

APPLYING OSMO TOP OIL

Stir well before use. Apply Osmo worktop oil thinly along the wood grain with a lint-free cloth removing any excess top oil. Allow to dry appropriately with good ventilation and repeat the process again. Your seating will be dry after 9 hours.
