

TAKING CARE OF YOUR OILED TIMBER SHELVES

Over time, your shelves will build up the rich, warm patina of time and use. To ensure the longevity of the shelves, and the continued beauty of the surface, please consider the guidance that follows.

CARF

This is a traditional finish that we love to use on busy work surfaces. Our oiled finishes are hard wearing and resistant to most spillages. However, any spills should be wiped immediately to avoid any chance of obvious marking. Avoid dragging objects across the surface and to prevent marking, ensure the surface is protected from extreme heat.

If you wish to avoid any obvious marking of the surface, please use mats for any hot plates, pans and other vessels.

Over time, your cabinet will build up the rich, warm patina of time and use. To ensure the longevity of the piece, and the continued beauty of the surface, we would suggest that the cabinet is re-oiled if you notice the surface becoming dry or it is marking too easily.

CIFANING

Use a soft, lightly dampened cloth to wipe the cabinet clean from time to time. You can also use the Osmo spray cleaner provided to clean and nourish the timber.

ENVIRONMENT

Your cabinet is made from solid timber, and as a natural material will never stop responding to its environment. This is wonderful thing! However, it does mean that fast, extreme or imbalanced changes in temperature or humidity, may affect the structure and longevity of the piece and should be avoided.
