## TAKING CARE OF YOUR OILED TIMBER CHAIRS

As your chairs have a natural oiled finish, they are protected, but won't be completely impervious to marking,

Over time, your chairs will build up the rich, warm patina of time and use.

To ensure the longevity of the chairs, and the continued beauty of the surface, please consider the guidance that follows.

### CARE

This is a traditional surface that we love to use on much-used pieces of furniture. Our oiled finishes are hard wearing and resistant to wine, juice and olive oil spillages. However, any spills should still be wiped immediately to avoid any chance of obvious marking.

### CLEANING

A soft, lightly dampened cloth should be used to wipe the chairs clean. We have provided a care pack with a nourishing Osmo spray that can be used from time to time.

### CUSHIONS

We use Romo Linara for our cushions. Linara is a washable cotton-linen blend that offers both practicality and durability.
